### **FACULTY PARTICIPATION AT RESIDENCY PROGRAM ORIENTATIONS**

Hospital reps shared their desired topics.

- **Aurora (Laura Janssen) – Pain management, anything on death and dying** (*especially when a family member is not on board with the care plan*)
- **Bellin Health (Kelly Verhasselt) – Opioid crisis**
- **HSHS (Sherry Willems) – Psych**

Information shared on these topics can be sent, involve hosting a speaker at the site, and can include role play.

- ✓ **College reps are asked to bring these topics back to their school to gather information and/or possibly provide a speaker for any of the site requested topics.**

Members shared some of the various resources they have used.

- Wisconsin [DHS](#) offers a lot of videos regarding the opioid crisis.
- NWTC built a sim focused on death and dying. They discuss the role of hospice and palliative care.
- Rasmussen College has had a funeral director come in to speak.
- Bellin College has hosted Hospice to discuss palliative care.
- A yoga instructor can be invited to focus on breathing, mindfulness, and how to reduce stress.
- [Connections for Mental Wellness](#) addresses community issues related to mental wellness and mental health care.
- Bellin's recent Strategy Day Away featured a TED talk from Fr. Greg Boyle. He discussed getting along and working together. Fr. Greg is the founder of [Homeboy Industries](#), the largest gang-intervention, rehabilitation, and reentry program in the world.
- [Lessons from Nursing to the World](#) – Kathleen Bartholomew - Kelly Verhasselt recommended this 20 minute "powerful" video.
- JoAnn recently saw a webinar put out by Duke University entitled '**Relationship Resilience: The Science of How Other People Matter**'. See attachment. The importance of relationships and the value of connecting is emphasized.

### **DR. LINDA CAPUTI PRESENTATION**

Members agreed to move forward with securing Dr. Linda Caputi to give an afternoon presentation at the Clinical Instructor's Orientation. Attached is a flyer from her 1/18/2019 presentation at Carroll University.

Members discussed splitting the cost to have Dr. Caputi speak amongst active GGBHA Clinical Committee organizations that will be in attendance. Dr. Caputi will need confirmation by the end of May.

- Bellin College's space will not be large enough to accommodate the expected 150+ attendees. Brian is checking with NWTC to possibly schedule the event in their auditorium. The space can hold up to 250 people. The Marq and Aurora were also discussed as possible venues.

- A lunch will be provided for people who attend the morning and afternoon sessions. NWTC's Canteen provides catering services.

### STUDENT FLOATING OFF INSTRUCTOR LEAD CLINICAL – BRIAN KROGH

Hospital reps shared that a student's ability to float off a department is situational, depending upon the site they are at. Floating off a department must be planned and preapproved. **Instructors must confirm that the floating student(s) has been approved.** Sites want to give students the best possible experience, but within reason and their guidelines. HSHS does not allow a student to float off a department during instructor led clinicals.

### STUDENT HAVING RESTRICTIONS DUE TO HEALTH/INJURIES – BRIAN KROGH

Hospital reps shared that if a student has lifting restrictions, an exposed brace, etc. how much *or* whether they can participate and/or observe in a clinical will be situational at the site. Their level of participation will be determined on a case by case basis and require a conversation with the dean.

### EASTERN WI ALLIANCE UPDATES & GGBHA WEBSITE HOST Continue or Change

Double work is being done. More unity is desired. Members would like to begin the process of merging with the Fox Valley and LakeShore Health Care Alliances. This could include a unified website.

### CASTLEBRANCH PILOT – LAURA JANSSEN

Aurora is currently at a standstill with the pilot due to their merger. It is too late for a summer pilot. Organizers will look to fall 2019 instead. Bellin College and NWTC reps have offered to participate.

### NURSING ASSISTANT COURSE – HOURS REDUCTION BILL

Brian shared there is currently a Wisconsin Assembly Bill and Senate Bill to reduce the nursing assistant course hours from 125 to 75. Many feel the limited course hours are not enough for students to master the nursing assistant role. WTCS schools are not allowed to voice their opinion as a WTCS employee; however, the clinical sites can. In addition, concerns can be shared with Senator Rob Cowles, a proponent of the bill. A copy of the Senate Bill is attached.
