MANDATORY MODULES

The HIPAA Privacy & Security orientation module was updated, based on HSHS comments. Updates included that students should not be storing, transferring or emailing PHI. Since today's meeting, the four updated modules have been launched with the new website (ggbha.org) platform.

COVID-19 UPDATES

The smaller clinical groups at HSHS are working well and will likely continue in fall. They are limited in where students can be placed and don't have the resources to fit test. Students cannot be put in the ICU, due to the fit testing requirement. PAPRs require a medical clearance. They are focusing on medical students that need to be in surgery and respiratory care. HSHS is screening (including students) at the department level each day.

Sherri Hanrahan, Bellin College, updated the group on the WI Board of Nursing regarding simulation. In Wisconsin, 50% of simulation can replace clinical hours for a program. During the COVID spike, the 50% threshold was expanded but this has since expired. Nursing program reps are inquiring about extending this. With the group sizes of four students, and needing simulation to replace missed clinical hours, this may affect nursing students graduating on time in the future, especially if students are not allowed in the clinical setting due to a second wave of COVID.

Summer students at Bellin Health are not allowed in the ICU, because there are too many new hires in the department. Since the 6/26 meeting, Kelly shared that Bellin Health is accepting students for their ICU. Kelly will inquire about nursing student clinicals in the OR. There is uncertainty as to what fall will bring, with the potential of a second COVID surge. Bellin is only screening visitors and patients, while employees self-screen. Students will be treated like employees and will be required to self-screen as well.

Aurora has brought back all disciplines of students and is still screening at the door. They have a couple of precepted students in their ICU for summer. 2 surgical can be requested for fall. A one-to-one can also be requested. An OR instructor-led experience is available, and they would also consider a precepted OR experience. Procedure masks will be available for students. Groups of four will be easier to have on the unit. Employee health will not fit test students.

Julie Williams recently learned that Rasmussen College will only be offering clinicals to their senior level students. Therefore, Julie may have some late summer clinical spaces to return to the sites.

CLINICAL PLACEMENT SOFTWARE & PILOT UPDATE – LAURA JANSSEN

The pilot has been completely put on hold for a year.

As of 6/29/2020, members are asked to also use the new student link for any Aurora placement requests. Members can process placement requests through Aurora's link but also attach the excel spreadsheet of their clinical placements, as

done in the past. Members are asked to email Laura to notify her of their placement request submission. Laura will let members know when their entire website is live.
