COVID UPDATES

Site protocols need to be followed by students/faculty regarding COVID symptoms, exposure, etc.

Due to the huge influx of regional COVID cases, **HSHS** reimplemented their incident command processes and reopened their COVID unit at St. Mary’s. Students need to be reminded about being socially conscious at all times, including outside of school and the workplace. Social distancing and masking need to be vigilantly practiced. This has been a big focus for colleagues while outside of work. HSHS continues to closely regulate supplies and is discussing their visitor’s policy for possible revision.

An email was recently sent to clarify entry procedures at **Advocate Aurora BayCare Medical Center**. Students and faculty can enter through the main entrance to get screened. Masks will be available. After screening, eye masks are available by walking down to the patient entrance. Advocate Aurora has COVID dedicated patient areas and is seeing an increase in COVID patients.
