REGIONAL HEALTHCARE CAREER PATHWAYS – NIKKI KISS

The Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction (DPI) is working with Inspire New North to create healthcare pathways every Wisconsin student will review as part of their Academic and Career Planning (ACP). All of the CESAs are partnering to work on this initiative. The project team connected with the GGBHA today to get feedback regarding regional 'Patient Care Career Pathways' (see attachment). The project team will also be connecting with other Wisconsin healthcare alliances for their feedback.

The State is focusing on patient care pathways for now. Each region picks the pathways they are going to develop. The New North has four pathways they are developing. Educators will localize and personalize the pathways for their schools. Each college will have its own page that lists its programs and dual credit options. Members are encouraged to contact [Nikki Kiss](#) with questions or additional pathway updates. More pathways will be added as the project team progresses.

UPDATE: CLINICAL PLACEMENT SOFTWARE PILOT – LAURA JANSSEN

Advocate Aurora will be utilizing [myClinicalExchange \(MCE\)](#) for the clinical placement software pilot. Tentatively, students going to an Advocate Aurora location will be placed in the platform starting in 2022, replacing Aurora's current process.

Members discussed the possibility of the GGBHA converting to the MCE platform, in addition to how its costs would be handled. Since the 2/26/2021 meeting, Laura reached out to Karen Ganey: *"We have one health care organization in town that uses MCE. Do we know from a student's angle if they pay one fee to access any MCE account? Or, are there multiple fees if you're doing clinical for each health care organization?"* Karen Ganey's response: *"Sandy said yesterday it would be one charge per student which would cover multiple health care organizations."*

The system that utilizes the GGBHA website is working for many of the sites with no added cost for the them or the students. Jessie shared that Prevea uses and is pleased with the MCE software for their precepted internships. Members decided the GGBHA will continue with its current process, as the majority of sites are trying to recoup from the pandemic. It was noted that any of the site compliance departments could override their site's current process.

After Advocate Aurora kicks-off their clinical placement software pilot, members will review the benefits for the schools and healthcare agencies. If considered viable, the GGBHA will host an MCE representative to learn more.

REVIEW: MANDATORY MODULES

All Modules

- Updated the edit dates on all of the slides.
- Changed the word *objectives* to *outcomes*.

Module: HIPAA PRIVACY & SECURITY - (S = Slide)

- S18 – Added a hyphen to 'de-identify', fourth check marked item.

Module: INFECTION PREVENTION

- S8 – Added: *If you are experiencing symptoms STAY HOME. You must follow your college and the site's notification policy.* Indicated they must follow the site's current guidelines for entry.
- S12 – Added: *No student will be taking care of a known COVID patient unless preapproved by the healthcare agency and academic setting.*
- S12 – Added: *If you have been accidentally exposed, you must follow the healthcare agency and academic setting's exposure procedures.*
- S15 – Added: *The CDC recommends getting the COVID vaccination.*
- S49 – Removed the word *bloodborne* from the titles.
- S50 – Removed the word *bloodborne* located before the word *Pathogens*.
- S51 through S55 – Removed the word *blood*, as it relates to exposure.
- S54 – Added the definition of an exposure shared by Laura Janssen at the meeting.
- S72 – Added: **Current COVID precautions require a surgical mask, goggles and face shield be worn to take patient vital signs.*

Module: PROFESSIONAL EXPECTATIONS IN THE WORKPLACE

- S20 – Indicated Paula Hafeman, HSHS, is retired.

Module: SAFETY IN THE WORKPLACE

- S59 – Changed the red font to white for the last bulleted item 'MRI Zone III & IV...'.
• S46 (New Slide) – Chemo Precautions

COVID UPDATES

- For now, the sites will be continuing with the smaller size clinical groups.
- State guidelines for gatherings need to be followed.
- Currently, the hospitals are not requiring indicating on an ID badge if the student has been COVID vaccinated.
