CLINICAL PLACEMENT SOFTWARE PILOT UPDATE – LAURA JANSSEN

School placement coordinators will be trained in mid-august. Actual instructors assigned to the clinical groups for placement will be trained at the end of 2021. Spring 2022 placement requests will be needed by Advocate Aurora (AAH) as follows.

- Instructor Led - October 1
- Preceptor Led - November 1

The fall pilot with Bellin college has been cancelled due to AAH not being ready yet. They will be ready to go live with the colleges for spring 2022.

COVID UPDATES

HSHS and Bellin Health will be going back to eight students per clinical group starting this summer. This can change if needed. AAH will decide on the group size for fall in the very near future. **UPDATE: On 6/11/2021, it was announced that ABMC has approval to increase instructor size clinicals groups to a max of 8 students/instructor starting fall 2021.**

At HSHS, an N95 mask will still be required for any patient receiving an aerosolizing procedure. Students cannot go into the room for one hour after the procedure without an N95 mask. HSHS will not conduct student fit testing or provide their N95s. Each student would need two N95s per shift. Student fit testing results, by specific brand, would need to be on file at the sites. Currently, HSHS does not allow students to bring in their own N95 mask but the policy is being reviewed. None of the hospitals will be fit testing students.

Screenings

- Bellin Health will screen students and faculty like visitors and patients. Screenings are done in the receptionist area at their ambulatory settings.
- HSHS is still doing door screenings.
- AAH's screening process is still the same. Students / faculty can use the app. They can be screened as a visitor if they don't have the app. All can enter through the main entrance.

Rasmussen University's summer quarter begins in July. All of their didactic courses will be kept online, with all labs back on campus. Each clinical course has set hours of clinical and simulation. They have been invited back to Rennes and will be back at HSHS, AAH, and Bellin.

Julie Williams has taken on a new role with Rasmussen University that will include Green Bay, Wausau, St. Cloud and Mankato, MN. Julie will be remote and traveling more but will continue to participate in the GGBHA. Ashley Otto will assume some of Julie's responsibilities.

Bellin College is back to pre-COVID status. NWTC will be back to normal in fall but are not sure when nursing assistant students will go back to onsite, long term care clinicals. The emergency training mode is still in effect. They will continue to watch for any DHS updates.

HSHS INTERNATIONAL NURSES

HSHS will have up to 30 international nurses starting in June. They will be in the ICUs and med/surg to start. Most of the nurses are from the Philippines, in addition to a few nurses from Africa. Students may have the opportunity to collaborate with them.
